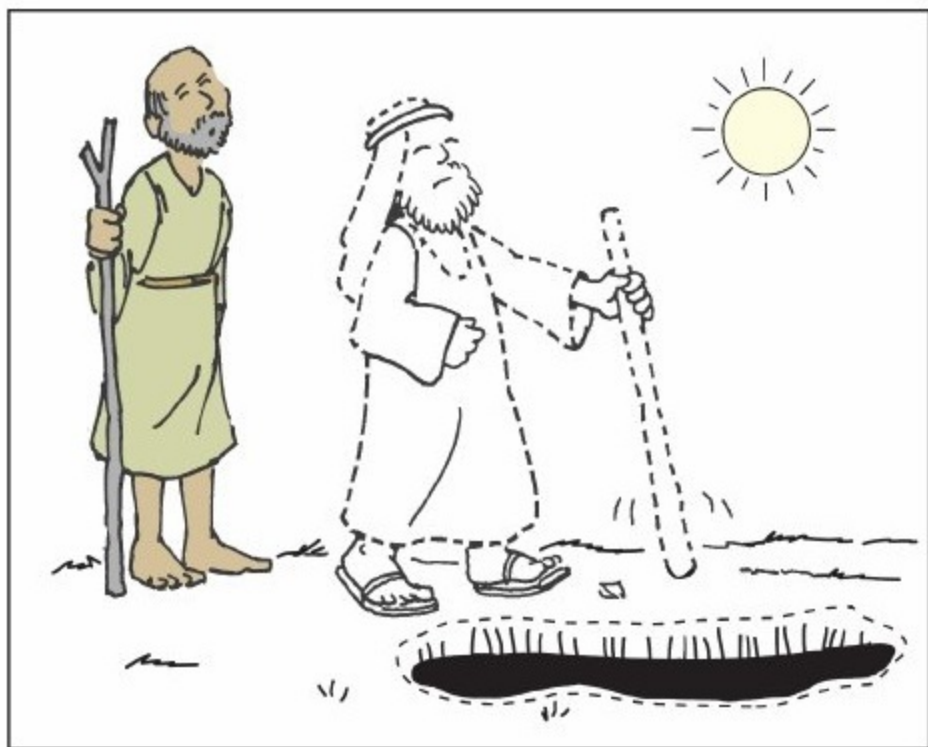


Jesus Tells a Parable

Trace the lines to finish the picture.

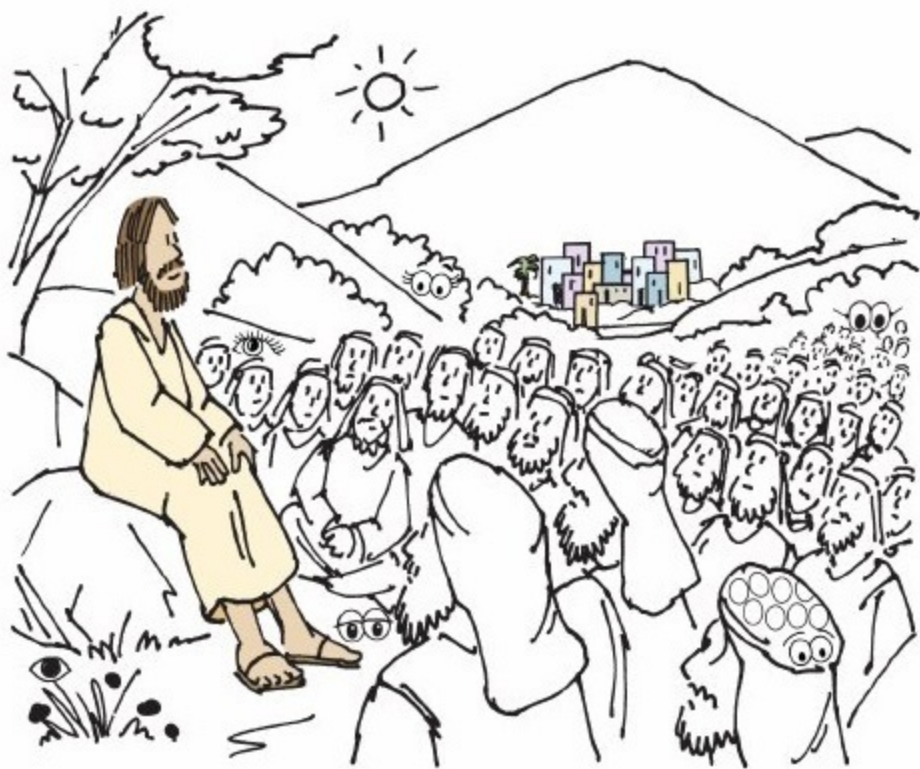
