Wife of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Farmer, being Weak, in Body but of sound and disposing Mind & memory Thanks be given unto God; calling unto mind the short stay of my Body and knowing that it is appointed, for all men to die, do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner & form following; that is to say, principally & first of all, I give & Recommend my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God that gives it, and my Body I Recommend to the Earth, to be decent Christian Burial, at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General resurrection; I shall receive the same again; by the mighty Power of God, And as touching such worldly Estate, wherewith it has pleased God to Bless me in this life; I Give, Devise, & Dispose of the same in the following Manner & form. First I direct that all my Just debts be Contented and paid within convenient Time after my decease; Item; I Give and Bequeath to my Well Beloved Wife, Ann, Huffer besides her thirds my Bed with its Furniture whereon we now lie also a Cow and Calf and two Spinning Wheels, the rest of my Estate both Real & Personal I leave to be Sold at publick Sale and the Moneys arising therefrom, to be (after my Wifes part is deducted) divided among my Children in the following manner; Item. I Give and Bequeath, to my daughter Rebecca Huffer, the Sum of ten pounds Current money, Item; I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Barbara Huffer the Sum of ten pounds Current Money, the above Legacies I have to be paid to my two Children above named, as soon as the Estate is Settled and as the Children shall come to age; by my Executors, the Rest of my Estate, after my Just debts and Legacies are paid by my Wifes Share is deducted, I have to be equally divided among my seven Children. Namely, Christiana; Christiana; Philip; Margaret; Daniel; John Casper; Catharine; Elizabeth; Adam; Hannah; Jacob; Susanna; & Magdalene; Rebecca & Barbara, Huffers And I Nominate and Appoint my Trusty & Well beloved Son in Law
